

<sup>44</sup> Jesus turned to the woman and said to Simon, "Do you see this woman? When I entered your home, you didn't give me water for my feet, but she wet my feet with tears and wiped them with her hair.



- 45 You didn't greet me with a kiss, but she hasn't stopped kissing my feet since I came in.
- 46 You didn't anoint my head with oil, but she has poured perfumed oil on my feet.



- <sup>47</sup> This is why I tell you that her many sins have been forgiven; so she has shown great love. The one who is forgiven little loves little."
- 48 Then Jesus said to her, "Your sins are forgiven."

- The other table guests began to say among themselves, "Who is this person that even forgives sins?"
- Jesus said to the woman, "Your faith has saved you. Go in peace."
